Hello! Here are all the details of our virtual sessions.

Meeting Time: Sundays from 2-4 Eastern time (New York time). (I ask models to log on between 15-20 minutes early, just to go over last minute details/questions, and check the set up and lighting before I start letting artists into the meeting) Also please allow for a few minutes at the end in the event we run a bit behind.

Compensation: Pay starts at \$100, and anything we make beyond that will be split with you. Payment will be sent via venmo or paypal directly following the session.

Pose Breakdown: 4 x 5 minute poses, *break*, 2 x 10 minute poses, *break*, and 3 x 20 minutes with a break between each. (breaks are usually between 3-4 minutes)

Technical needs: So first off, you will need some sort of device with a camera and access to Zoom (typically phones have provided the best quality. They usually have better cameras than those built into laptops). You will need a space large enough that we can get full body poses without cutting off hands and feet. Decent lighting is also important. It doesn't have to be studio lighting or anything, but good enough so we can make out the details. And obviously decent enough internet for there to not be any connection issues.

What is expected: The two most important things we need from you is 1) to be able to stay (mostly) still throughout the length of the pose, and 2) to get your full body in frame.

Our goal for the sessions is to have an erotic undertone, but to what level you want to play with that idea it is up to you and your comfort level (For example, erections are welcomed but not at all required. Something more implied would also be welcome. In general, I think it is more about bringing a level of sensuality to the poses. And I am happy to discuss with you beforehand to find something you are comfortable with). First and foremost, our artists are all there to create art. A number of us tend to focus on more erotic subject matter, but I want to be clear that an interesting, well-held pose is the priority. Some costume pieces/props (a jock, underwear, harnesses, etc) are fine if you'd like, but generally keep it to a minimum, and nothing too detailed, as it can be difficult to see on a small screen. We do ask for full nudity at least for the 20 minute poses.

I typically don't give too much guidance with the poses during the session, other than slight adjustments to get your feet, head, etc. into frame, so the poses are up to you. I find that usually lets the model's personality shine through a bit more, which makes for more interesting artwork. Throughout the session, we'd love to see a variety of angles, and especially for the shorter poses, the more dynamic the better. As well as a mix of standing, seated, reclined (as best as your set up allows for).

Promo Art: We do need a couple hi-res for promo images we can use on our instagram/twitter/mailing list. Basically, as high quality as possible shirtless photo (face and torso), similar to the ones on our IG **@doableguys** (something along the lines of this). I also would want to confirm if you'd want to be tagged or mentioned in posts. Please email them to doableguys@gmail.com. Feel free to send as many as you'd like. We will use the best ones.

Booking: We are typically booked at least a month or two in advance, although sometimes dates can open up sooner due to cancellations. We try our hardest to set up a diverse line up of models, so we will try to find the best possible date for you.

Please let me know if all of this sounds good, or if you have any other questions. I would also ask that if you haven't already, please let me know what your experience level is, as well as making sure I have an idea of what you look like.
